Enoggera State School will receive**

**\$105, 926**

### This funding will be used to

- Work towards 100% of students achieving the National Minimum Standard in reading, spelling and writing. Ensure individual students who either fall below or are identified at risk of falling below the NMS have an individual learning plan in place.
- Embed an improvement agenda which has a sharp focus on increasing the proportion of students in the upper 2 Bands in Year 3 and Year 5 Reading, Spelling and Writing.
- Improve overall Enoggera State School NAPLAN percentiles with the aspirational target of a 10% increase in each year level/ area.
- Embed whole of school programs in Reading and Spelling.
- Develop a whole school approach to the teaching of Writing
- Build capacity of staff to plan, implement and assess utilising a consistent pedagogical framework.

### Our initiatives include

- Developing teacher capacity to gather reliable, consistent and comparable data around student achievement. Develop teacher capacity to utilise this data in order to better understand the learning needs of their students.
- Establish Professional Learning Communities that build data literacy and the foundation of the Enoggera Early Intervention Program.
- Maintain training of key staff to implement Enoggera Early Years Intervention Program
- Embed targeted Literacy Blocks across all year levels with a focus on Reading and Writing
- Undertake targeted extension programs in Writing and Reading as a driver for improved upper 2 bands performance.
- Embed 'Case Management' processes and practices within school meeting cycle structure.
- Collaborative and facilitated 'Data and Planning Days'
- Focussed peer observation and feedback around the teaching of writing and reading
- Targeted utilisation of school budget to enhance student/ teacher ratio in Literacy Blocks.
