- Implement a Professional Learning Community (PLC) model, observation and feedback, coaching and mentoring strategies to support teachers with developing best practice.
- Enable the PLC model to provide time and space for teachers to work with the HOD-C, STLaN and Inclusion teacher around planning with a focus on differentiation and Case Management.
- Continue to build staff capabilities in catering for diverse learners, including high achieving students.
- Enable the PLC model to refine school-wide approaches to Reading and Spelling.
- Enable the PLC model to refine the school-wide focus on Writing, including a consistent approach to Learning Walls and providing student feedback in English.
- Continue to provide further enrichment opportunities for students in the Arts.
- Continue to provie early intervention and support to students with speech language difficulties.

### Our initiatives include

- Ensuring the progress of our English A-E results move more students into the A/B grades as per like schools.
- Ensuring progress of Writing achievement in NAPLAN from Yr 3 to 5 is similar to like schools with more students moving into the Upper 2 Bands.
- Using the Lynn Sharratt work to guide the implementation of the PLC model, Case Management, Learning Walls and Feedback to students.
- Developing a school-wide consistent approach to supporting our diverse learners.
- Increasing student access to Instrumental Music in Strings.
